*Keyway Violation (3 seconds) is not a specific '1,2,3' count. 3 seconds is determined according to the effect that player has on the game at that time. Players that are new to the game may not have this rule enforced but be encouraged to move in and out of the keyway.

** Throw in Violation (5 Seconds) is not specific to a straight 1-5 count. Players that are new to the game may have not have this rule enforced but be encouraged to pass ball in quickly in order to progress the game.

Mercy Rule: When the difference between two team's scores is equal to the amount specified in the table above, the offensive team must return to the designated area when the defensive team gains possession and remain there until the defending team move into the area.

Defence: We do not have a policy against zone defence. However, we encourage teams to play 'player on player' defence to teach spacing, guarding their own player and establish fair play for all

Bonus Foul Shots: Two shots are awarded on the 8th team foul in a half. And for each subsequent foul for the remainder of the half (except offensive fouls).

Jump Balls: For a held ball violation, a jump ball is conducted rather than the use of a directional arrow.

Accessories: All accessories such as jewellery, watches, fit-bits, etc, must be removed before play can commence. If jewellery cannot be removed, then it is required by the Centre that it be covered by sports tape which is available at the Centre office.

Accessories can be exempted on the grounds of religious beliefs or medical purposes, but this must be organised and approved by Centre Management

Player Uniforms: Players must ensure they follow the guidelines set out by the Participation guide with regards to pockets, belts, buckles, and belt loops. Centre management reserves the right to exclude any player who violates these conditions.

A junior player is able to play in their school uniform as long as it doesn't violate the conditions listed above

Approaching junior officials before, during, or after the game with any form of discussion, whether it be complimentary, criticism, constructive feedback, or rule clarification is NOT PERMITTED.
