



Hygiene Policy

As part of our Return to Sport Plans we have developed a Hygiene Policy. This Anyway you're sorry I was like what is that is in place for the safety of our staff, officials, and patrons (players, spectators, hirers etc.). It outlines the added cleaning and disinfecting procedures our centres will be implementing upon our re-opening, as well as general guidelines for Staff, Officials & Patrons. The Hygiene Policy in its entirety is a lengthy 12-pages, and it is for the most part, only relevant to our staff. Below are some key points that are relevant to our Patrons, on what we are doing and how you can assist us.

Please ensure all members of your team or hire group, read these guidelines, and abide by them when visiting our centres.

Key Points for Patrons (players, spectators, etc.)

- It is expected that if you are unwell you will not play / attend our centres
- We recommend all persons entering our centres install the COVIDSAFE app on their phone
- Use the “Get in, Play/Train, Get Out” mentality. Do not spend time in the centres just for the sake of it.
- Arrive ready to play / train (uniform, shoes, strapping, etc.)
- Register as a player before your first game. ^
^ If required your names & contact details will be supplied to SA Health in the case of contact with a confirmed case
- Wash / Sanitise Hands before and after playing / training
- Do not share drink bottles. Drink fountains will be temporarily unavailable for use
- Avoid sharing food (oranges, lollies, etc.)
- Use a tissue if you do cough or sneeze & dispose of tissue immediately, then wash/sanitise hands
- Avoid touching face (especially nose, eyes, mouth)
- Space out on benches, sit separately from other teams/spectators & maintain at least 1.5 metres between you and other people wherever possible
- No Handshakes after game. Instead an elbow or fist bump, or simply saying “Good Game”, “Well Played” etc. will suffice. Avoid high-fives and other such contact during your game / training
- Pay via contactless card payment where possible, when purchasing drinks/food, sporting goods or paying match/hire fees etc. (cash payments are not an issue if hand hygiene guidelines are followed after use.)
- Hirers are required to supply own equipment (balls, bibs, cones, etc.)
- Patrons may opt to wear face masks. This includes whilst playing, if worn on court masks must be soft and securely fastened to face

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Cleaning and Disinfecting Procedures

- **Match Balls (and Futsal (Soccer) warm-up balls)**
Will be cleaned at the beginning and end of each day and will be disinfected between games.
- **Score Desks, iPads, Score Clocks/Boards and Stationery**
Will be cleaned at the beginning and end of each day and will be disinfected whenever the scorer changes.
- **Bibs**
Will be only used once. After use they will be laundered before being used again.
- **Court Equipment (goals, nets, etc)**
After handling equipment, the handler will be required to wash hands immediately.
- **Nail Clippers**
Will be cleaned at the beginning and end of each day and will be disinfected between games.
- **First Aid**
Gloves will be worn for all First Aid treatments. All re-useable items used will be cleaned/disinfected after each use. Disposable items used will be disposed of immediately.

In addition to the above list our staff will be following cleaning/disinfecting procedures for many more items/surfaces within our Centres, including office spaces, door handles, bathrooms, etc.

Temporarily Unavailable

To assist in maintaining a COVID Safe environment, the following will be temporarily unavailable.

- Drinking Fountains – tap for filling water bottles is available at Unley
